Dr. Joseph Silvio is a psychiatrist and psychoanalyst in private practice in Bethesda, Maryland, Assistant Clinical Professor of Psychiatry at the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences, and a Teaching Analyst at the Washington Center for Psychoanalysis. He is a Founding Member of the Institute for Contemporary Psychotherapy and Psychoanalysis, an organization focused on self psychology.
